This **Memorandum of Understanding**, by and between the Northwest Local Board of Education [hereinafter referred to as "Board"], and Ohio Association of Public School Employees Local #376 [hereinafter referred to as "OAPSE"], is to address the retirement of a bargaining unit employee as it relates to Article 40.1 of the Negotiated Agreement.

Whereas, the Negotiated Agreement sets forth that certain employees are eligible for health insurance opt-out bonus; and

Whereas, the Negotiated Agreement did not clearly address the process if an eligible employee retires from his/her position during the current eligibility period; and

Whereas, the eligibility period is November 1 through October 31 of the current enrollment year; and

Whereas, the Board and OAPSE wish to clarify the intent of Article 40.1

NOW, THEREFORE, In consideration of the foregoing, the Board and OAPSE hereby agree that Article 40.1 shall include the following provision:

Bargaining unit employee who retires from the Board after the open period commences [November 1], but before the next open period commences [October 31], and who is eligible to receive the bonus shall receive a pro-rated payment. This pro-rated amount shall be calculated based on a twelve [12] month period. Each month worked after the open period [November 1] will be equal to \$166.66 (\$2,000/12 months). The bonus shall be paid with his/her final paycheck.
