## SECOND AMENDMENT TO POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT

This SECOND AMENDMENT TO POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT (this "Second Amendment"), is made and entered into as of the last date set forth on the signature page below ("Effective Date") by and between SunEx Solar-NLS LLC, a Michigan limited liability company, and its assignee, Powerfund One LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Provider"), and its subsidiaries, and Northwest School District Board of Education, an Ohio body politic and corporate (together "Customer"). Provider and Customer are each referred to individually herein as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

#### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, Provider and Customer have entered into a Power Purchase Agreement on October 31, 2017 ("PPA"), pursuant to which Provider is to deliver to Customer electric energy generated by a solar energy system to be installed, financed, and operated by Provider and pursuant to which Customer is to purchase all electric energy generated by such solar energy system over a term of 25 years at USD 0.0800 per kWh, escalating at 2.20% per year;

WHEREAS, the PPA has been amended by that certain First Amendment to Power Purchase Agreement dated [\_\_\_\_\_].

WHEREAS, Capitalized terms in this Second Amendment shall have the meaning given to them in the PPA, unless this Second Amendment specifically states to the contrary.

WHEREAS, Provider and Customer have agreed to modify the PPA as provided in this Second Amendment in respect to the Proposed Energy Storage Solution Deliverables as set forth on Exhibit A1 of the PPA, which was intentionally left unspecified when the PPA was executed, due to the need for additional work related to accessing the sizing and scope of work necessary to the customer's needs, which PowerFund at the time of purchase was unaware of. During the course of accessing the needs of the customer it was determined that battery storage would not meet the customers' needs and a propane generator was determined a better solution to meet the customer needs which included extended emergency stand by energy. Both parties agree to this resolution to be acceptable resolution of this obligation and following amendment resolves any and all outstanding issues related to Northwest Schools including but not limited to those related the completion of the project, project scope and fulfilment of all obligations by the original developers, sales organizations and PowerFund One to Northwest Schools.

#### **AGREEMENT**

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, Provider and Customer agree to amend the PPA Agreement as follows:

- 1. <u>Amendment of Exhibit A1</u>. Exhibit A1 of the PPA shall be deleted in its entirely and Provider agrees as follows in consideration of Customer's promises set forth hereinafter:
  - a. Provider will install a 130Kw, 480V propane generator in "turn key" state of operation, on the Customer location in a protected shelter with a fuel tank sufficient for 3 days of stand by power generation to augment the System.
  - b. Provider will pay for the cost of the propane generator equipment, and the installation and maintenance during the life of contract.
  - c. Customer will be responsible for the propage fuel to operate the generator

- d. Provider will bill monthly for the energy production of the solar system and generator going forward and Customer shall pay the rates set forth on Exhibit E.
- 2. Amendment of Exhibit D (Definition of "Termination Amount") and Exhibit F (Termination Amount). Exhibit F is hereby deleted in its entirety. The definition of the term "Termination Amount" is hereby replaced and amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"Termination Amount" shall mean the sum of (a) all of Customer's due and unpaid payment obligation as of the effective date of Termination, (b) the net present value of Customer's remaining payment obligations under this PPA from the effective date of Termination until the end of the Term (had the Termination not occurred), discounted at a 4% discount rate, (c) any costs incurred by Provider for removal of the System, and (d) Provider's reasonable attorneys' fees.

3. Amendment of Exhibit D and Exhibit G (Termination Amount). Exhibit G is hereby deleted in its entirety. The definition of the term "Buyout Amount" is hereby added to Exhibit D to read as follows:

"Buyout Amount" shall mean the sum of (a) all of Customer's due and unpaid payment obligation as of the effective date of Termination, and (b) the net present value of Customer's remaining payment obligations under this PPA from the effective date of Termination until the end of the Term (had the Termination not occurred), discounted at a 4% discount rate,

- 4. <u>Amendment of Section 10 (Term)</u>. <u>Section 10.1</u> is here hereby amended to provide for a term of twenty-seven (27) years after the Commercial Operations Date.
  - 5. Amendment of Exhibit E. Exhibit E is hereby amended to add the following fields:

"Year 26=\$0.095 Year 27=\$0.095

- 6. <u>Approval of Assignment.</u> Customer hereby acknowledges, accepts and agrees to the assignment and transfer of the PPA from American Energy Renewable LLC and Sun Ex Solar LLC to the PowerFund One, LLC, and to any future assignment by PowerFund One, LLC to any entity affiliated with it or under its management or control.
- 7. Payment of Outstanding Invoices. Customer promises to pay all outstanding invoices under the PPA as of the Effective Date in the amount of the attached invoices through the date of this amendment within 14 days after the Effective Date.
- 8. No further Amendment. This amendment completes the scope of work required by the Customer under the terms of the PPA and related agreements and resolves any and all outstanding issues the Customer has under the terms of the PPA and any and all sale agreements. Except as modified by this and the First Amendment, the PPA all other terms remain in full force and effect between Provider and Customer.
