89-22 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ONE-TIME PAYMENTS TO TEACHERS, NON-TEACHING SCHOOL EMPLOYEES AND ADMINISTRATIVE EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, COVID-19, a communicable respiratory disease, caused a state of emergency throughout Ohio and interruptions in education and employment during recent school years; and

WHEREAS, such closures required the provision of student services by District employees that resulted in additional efforts made by them; and

WHEREAS, school districts across the State of Ohio are experiencing staffing shortages and difficulties retaining employees as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the law allows districts to spend their Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II and ARP ESSER) dollars on a broad range of "Allowable Activities" to prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus, to provide additional compensation to staff that have assumed new duties because of COVID-19,

and/or to address recruitment or retention challenges in light of the pandemic, including, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. Coordinate preparedness and response efforts of the school district to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19.
- 2. Activities to address unique needs of low-income students, students with disabilities, English learners, racial and ethnic minorities, students experiencing homelessness, foster youth.
- 3. Develop and implement procedures and systems to improve the preparedness and response efforts of the LEA.
- 4. Plan and implement summer learning and supplemental after-school activities.
- 5. Addressing learning loss by: administering and using high-quality assessments to assess students' academic progress and meet students' academic needs, including through differentiating instruction; implementing evidence-based activities to meet the comprehensive needs of students; providing information and assistance to parent and families on how they can effectively support students, including in a distance learning environment; and/or tracking student attendance and improving student engagement in distance education.
- 6. School facility repairs and improvements to enable operation of schools to reduce risk of virus transmission and exposure to environmental health hazards, and to support student health needs.
- 7. Inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, replacement, and upgrade projects to improve the indoor air quality in school facilities, including mechanical and non-mechanical heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems, filtering, purification and other air cleaning, fans, control systems, and window and door repair and replacement.
- 8. Other activities necessary to maintain the operations and continuity of services in the LEA and continuing to employ existing staff of the LEA; and

WHEREAS, during the 2021-2022 school year, teaching and nonteaching employees and principals, assistant principals, assistant superintendents, directors, supervisors, and other management level employees of the Northwest Local School District Board of Education ("Board"), including the Superintendent and Treasurer, have been responsible for a wide range of responsibilities included in the Allowable Activities, described above, which exceeded their normal job responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Local School District Board of Education wishes to provide compensation to recognize its employees who have supported District students during the pandemic and to retain existing staff and administrators throughout the District to continue its educational mission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Northwest Local School District, Scioto County, Ohio as follows:

1. The Board authorizes and directs the Treasurer to make a one-time, \$4,500.00 payment to all Board employees (teaching, nonteaching, and administrative)

Such payments shall be made to compensate employees for performing Allowable Activities during the 2021-2022 school year and as a retention bonus to reward employees for serving the District's students through the 2022-2023 school year.

- 2. The amount of the stipend specified in paragraph 1 is the gross amount, which shall be subject to applicable taxes, withholdings and deductions, including SERS or STRS retirement contributions, as applicable.
- 3. The stipend referenced in paragraph 1 above shall be made in a single lump sum on the second pay date in September 2022 for certified/classified employees and on the second pay date in October 2022 for administrative/nonunion employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board will utilize its ESSER II and American Rescue Plan (ARP ESSER) monies in making these payments, to the extent permitted by law, and will utilize general fund monies when use of ESSER II and ARP ESSER monies are not permitted.
