### 50-23 RESOLUTION TO ARM STAFF MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Northwest Local School District Board of Education believes that its first priority is to ensure the safety of the District's students and staff;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has taken a number of steps to ensure that it is providing a safe and proper learning environment for its students and a safe and proper workplace for its staff;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to R.C. 2923.122(D)(1)(a), the Ohio General Assembly has empowered local boards of education to authorize certain individuals to convey or otherwise possess a deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance into a school safety zone; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education desires to authorize certain staff members to convey or possess a deadly weapon in a school safety zone in an effort to further provide for the safety of the District's students and staff;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Northwest Local School District Board of Education:

**SECTION 1.** The individuals who have satisfied all statutory and Board

policy requirements and are hereby authorized to convey or possess a deadly weapon in a school safety zone shall not have their names made public and will be redacted upon

public request in order to protect these individuals.

**SECTION 2.** The Board President and the Superintendent shall provide

written authorization to the individuals authorized above to convey or possess a deadly weapon in a school safety zone.

**SECTION 3.** The Superintendent shall ensure that the individuals

authorized above shall comply with all subsequent statutory and Board policy requirements, including but not limited to the annual requalification and training and an annual criminal records check, in order to maintain their ability to

convey or possess a deadly weapon in a school safety zone.

**SECTION 4.** The Board President and the Superintendent shall ensure

that the public has been notified, by the means typically used to relay communications, of the Board's decision to authorize one or more persons to convey or possess a

deadly weapon in a school safety zone.

**SECTION 5.** This Resolution shall take effect on the earliest date

allowed by law.
