Dear School Community,

Northwest Local School District is committed to the safety and health of our students and staff. We want to inform you that that we have recently received information that <u>Northwest Elementary School</u> had (3) students tested positive and (0) staff. <u>Northwest Middle School</u> had (1) students tested positive and (1) staff tested positive while <u>Northwest High School</u> had (3) students tested positive and (1) staff tested positive for COVID-19. We are working closely with the Scioto County Health Department and anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by the health department as a part of COVID-19 investigation.

Northwest District will remain on its current schedule at this time.

We ask you to take these steps to continue to be aware of your health:

- 1. As a precaution, consider postponing plans for play dates, family visits, and extracurricular and social according to Scioto County Health Department Guidlines.
- 2. Continue to check your child for COVID-19 symptoms daily: fever or chills, new uncontrolled cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain, new onset of severe headache, especially with fever.
 - If anyone in your household develops symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19, they should immediately isolate and call Scioto County Health Department 740- 355-8358. Also contact your medical providers.

• If NO symptoms develop and you have not been instructed otherwise to quarantine for a different exposure, your child may continue to attend school.
