Author of the Week




For this installment of Author of the Week, the author chosen is British author J.K. Rowling, J.K. Rowling is how she's most commonly known, but her full name is Joanne Kathleen Rowling. She was born July 31, 1965 near Bristol, England. Rowling graduated from the University of Exeter in 1986, and after she did, she began working for Amnesty International in London. It was there she began to write the enthralling adventures of *Harry Potter*. In the 1990s, she traveled to Portugal to teach English, where she had a brief marriage and gave birth to her daughter. Soon after, she returned to the United Kingdom and settled in Edinburgh. The first novel in her beloved *Harry Potter* series, *Harry Potter and* the Philosopher's (Sorcerer's) Stone, was an immediate success, loved by both adults and children. The book was published under the name J.K. Rowling, as her publisher suggested a gender-neutral pen name to be used. The *Harry Potter* series is what she is famously known for, and she created numerous spin-offs and short stories connected to that wondrous fictional world she created, such as the Fantastic Beasts series, Quidditch Through the Ages, The Tales of Beedle the Bard, and Harry Potter and the Cursed Child. She also made children's books, The Christmas Pig and The Ickabog. Not only those, but J.K. Rowling made adult fiction tales, which were The Casual Vacancy, The Cuckoo's Calling, The Silkworm, Career of Evil, Lethal White, Troubled Blood, and The Ink Black Heart. J.K. Rowling is still alive and creating astounding stories to this day.





The Life of Chef Hector Boiardi (Chef Boyardee) The Man Behind The Can

The Beginning

Hector Boiardi was born on October 22nd, 1897 in Piacenza, Italy. Hector was born into a family with his father, mother, and two brothers. Ever since Hector was a child, he had worked in the food industry. By the age of 11, he was working in a local restaurant as an apprentice chef. Even though he was called an apprentice, he spent much of his time peeling potatoes and doing chores for the business. By the time he was a teenager, he had moved to Paris and then onto London where he started actually cooking. Finally, at age 16, he sailed to Ellis Island as a real chef.

The Career of the Spagnetti Man

Once in America, he went to work with his brother, Paolo, at the Plaza Hotel, New York, where he eventually became the head chef. After working for the Plaza Hotel, he went to the Greenbrier to work at a local hotel that would eventually lead him to be the caterer for President Woodrow Wilson's 2nd wedding. Soon, Boiardi had his own restaurant up and running called Il Giardino d'Italia in Cleveland, Ohio by 1926. Hector's pasta sauce was so popular, he started to put it in milk bottles and sell them. The demand for his sauce became so high, he needed to start factory production. The sauce sales even surpassed Chef Boiardi's restaurant. In 1938, Hector moved his factory to Milton, Pennsylvania and started to think about selling nationally. He then changed his name to Chef Boyardee so people knew how to pronounce his name correctly. In 1946, Chef Boyardee sold his brand to American Home Foods for 6 million dollars.

The Death of Can man

Chef Boyardee died on June 21st, 1985 due to natural causes. He was 87 years old when he died. The rest of his company went to American Home Foods. Chef Boyardee had a net worth of \$60 million when he died.
